Competitors compete at their own risk. The Judges decision is final.

The G&DWPC Inc Committee reserves the right to cancel or Alter any Event.

The Show will run under **AQHA Rules**

Open must be ridden in their age appropriate headgear.

Snaffle Bit & Hackamore must be ridden two handed.

Bridle, one handed.

No illegal equipment or training aids permitted in marshalling area or arena within 1 Hour of show.

Youth must produce proof of age if required.

Amateur/ Select Amateur cards must be shown when nominating.

Registration papers **must** be presented if requested.

Copy of registration papers for all halter classes must be supplied.

ALL DOGS must be on leash and controlled by owners

AT ALL TIMES.

All entries received or postmarked after the 14th will incur a \$25 late fee, after 5pm Friday is deemed 'on the day' and will incur a \$50 late fee

The onus is on YOU, the competitor to collect your prize money before office closes after the show. If you are competing on Saturday as well, you only need to pick it up on Sunday before office closes at end of show. NO prize money will be posted out unless a prior arrangement is made. If not picked up or arrangements made it will be deemed a donation to the club.

Competitor's/participants at any event run by Gunalda & Districts Western Performance Club Inc. have a responsibility to ensure the welfare of their horses and at all times to treat their horses humanely and with dignity, respect and compassion.

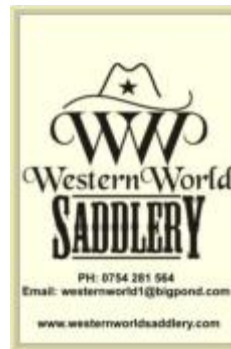
