Adding her considerable global contacts to those spread among RMC faculty, Marilyn manages the equine intern ship program.

Marilyn is a graduate of Colorado State University and Northwestern University. She is also an accredited judge with AQHA, NRHA, NSBA, APHA, NRCHA and an FEI-I rated

reining judge. When not teaching she is often traveling to judge for these associations. She has traveled to 13 countries to judge and judged such prestigious events as the AQHA World Show, AQHA Select World Show, AQHYA World Show, APHA World Show, NRHA Futurity, All American Quarter Horse Congress, and the European Championships. Marilyn was on the ground jury at the USEF/FEI Battle in the Saddle to select the Reining team for the USA at the 2010 World Equestrian Games. In addition, she will be a steward in that division. In her spare time she plans to show her reiner. She represents Montana as a National Director for AQHA and serves as chairperson for the AQHA Youth Committee. Marilyn also serves on the Board of Directors for NSBA.
